Each transfer will be considered by the Leagues Management Committee (LMC) who may refuse the transfer if it is considered to be detrimental to cricket in Jersey.

However it is the general view of the Jersey Cricket Board (JCB) that all Players have the right to choose which Club that they will play for. With this principle in mind it is important that transfers between Clubs are actioned without delay. It is unreasonable for the Club that the Player is leaving to stall his/her transfer, if this is the case the LMC will be prepared to complete the transfer without the clearance of that Club. To facilitate this process the LMC has designed a procedure with speed in mind.

Once the transfer has been approved by the LMC the only reason that a transfer will not go ahead will be if there are still monies owed to the Club the Player is leaving. In this case the Player will not be permitted to play for his new Club until payment has been cleared. I.e. the Player is effectively suspended until payment has been received.

Players may only transfer once per calendar year in each League.
